# MITSU AB<sup>™</sup> Polyglactin 910 Suture Study

#### **Study Highlights**

- This was a prospective, multicenter, post-marketing, randomized-controlled, singleblind, comparative study between MITSU AB<sup>™</sup> Polyglactin 910 Suture and VICRYL<sup>®</sup> Plus Polyglactin 910 Suture who underwent abdomen, uterus, vaginal and perennial surgery

#### Clinical outcomes

None of the patients, in either arm, exhibited the signs of wound dehiscence at 14 days, 30 days and 6 months follow-up visits

There was no adverse event or serious adverse event reported in the study

There was no incidence of surgical site infection till 6 months in either arm

The safety and efficacy of MITSU AB is comparable to Vicryl Plus suture
